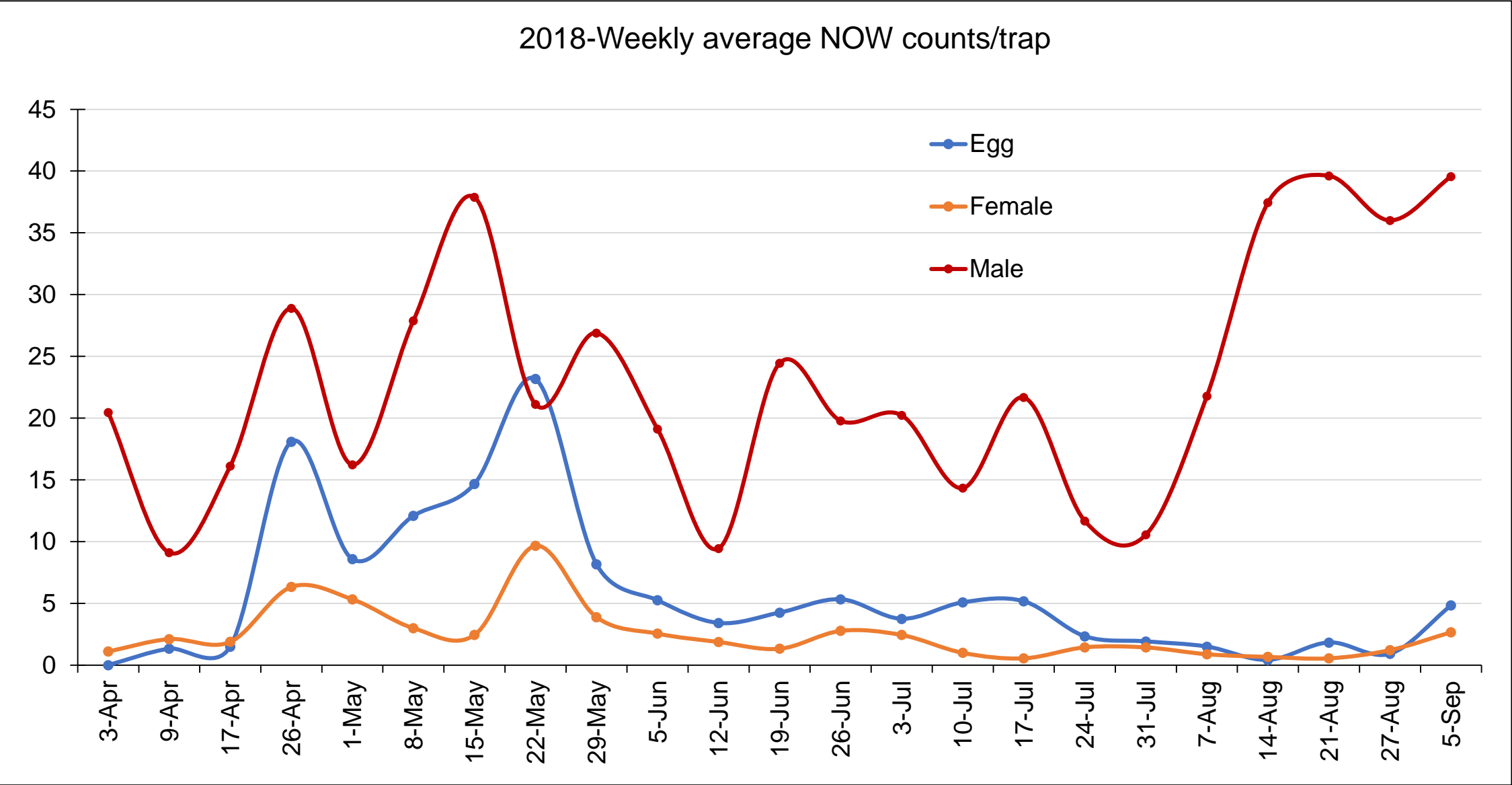

NOW this week:

- As you can see in the figure, male moth capture is still going strong in its 4th week (averaging 35-39 moths/wk). Now, the female (>2.5 moths/wk) and egg captures (~5 eggs/wk) are in increasing trend. Remember that female and egg traps are competing with the split nuts. These numbers are based on the 9 traps across 3 sites in the Modesto area.
- Increased female activity in traps is certainly a concern as some the pollinizer varieties in San Joaquin, and Stanislaus Counties are still on the tree
